

**Minutes for the March 25, 2013 Shore Drive Community Coalition General Meeting**

Meeting Location: Ocean Park Volunteer Rescue Squad Meeting Hall

Meeting Start: Called to order at 7:32pm by David Williams. 12 attendees.

Special Guest – Mr. John Burkard, Ocean Park Volunteer Rescue Squad Executive Board, discussed the efforts to raise funds and supplies to support the Eastern Shore Fire/Rescue squad arson response efforts. The local donations have been great so far. John also reminded us that all VB rescue squads are independent and have to raise their own monies for equipment. OPVRS provides service from Taste Unlimited to 76<sup>th</sup> Street to Cox HS. It has 50 members and is one of the smallest squads in VB.

Special Presentation – Mr. David Williams talked about Computer Fraud and Security Issues. Banking/credit cards with proximity sensors can be read through clothing, you need to block this or get a different card. Email “Phishing” is always an unsolicited request for information, don’t provide information unless you made the initial request. Remove CCO and add “See photo ID” on back of credit cards. Beware of IRS scams especially around tax time. Not all scams and frauds are online or over the phone. Beware of home repair scams that agree to do one small job, but keep adding more and more work. Don’t unsubscribe from unsolicited emails, these are random checks to gather legit email address for more spam. The VB Police Dept. will be holding two free forums on Identity Theft. 1) Tues April 9<sup>th</sup> at Central Library from 6-9pm and 2) Sat April 13 from 8:30am-11am at TCC.
