Name Change

Pursuant to the directive from the Committee at last month's meeting, an ad hoc committee discussed the changing of the Committee's name from the Bayfront Advisory Committee to its original name: the Shore Drive Advisory Committee. This ad hoc committee decided by acclamation that a name change was not in the best interests of the Committee.

Eminent Domain

City Council, by an eleven to zero vote, approved an ordinance to acquire by agreement or condemnation, right-of-way and easements for ten (10) parcels necessary for construction of the new Lesner Bridge. The City received Governor's Transportation Plan funding for the project in July 2011, and was given approval to begin the right-of-way phase on February 1, 2012.
