Dear Property Owner or Resident:

This letter is to inform you the City of Virginia Beach Department of Public Works is scheduled to commence construction along Dinwiddie Road from East Stratford Road to Lockhaven Crescent and along the south edge of Lockhaven Neighborhood Park to the Winston Place Stormwater Pump Station. The construction is estimated to be complete by June 2014.

The purpose of the drainage project is to reduce the frequency of tidal flooding up to Elevation 5.0 (NAVD88) in the vicinity of the intersection of Dupont Circle and Dinwiddie Road. Overland tidal flooding above elevation 5.0 will not be relieved by this project.

The proposed drainage route was selected during a Public Information Meeting that was held on **Thursday, Feb. 23, 2012** at the **Ocean Park Volunteer Rescue**, located at **3769 East Stratford Road** and was endorsed by the Ocean Park Civic League.
