Subject: CIP 6-552 Sanitary Sewer System Revitalization Program Ph II – Ocean Park Powhatan area Sewer Line Work

Dear Resident:

A contractor working for the City of Virginia Beach Public Utilities will be replacing sanitary sewer lines in the middle of West Stratford Road. The work will begin approximately on Wednesday February 12, 2014 and will last about 3 months. Note that **the street will be closed** a good portion of the time. This is unavoidable, as most of the work will be performed in the middle of the road, and excavation is very deep. Please be aware of these construction activities.

During the construction, heavy trucks will be driving through the Ocean Park Powhatan area. Most of the work will take place along West Stratford Road. The contractor will repair any damage to the grass/driveway that occurs during construction. The map on the back of this notice shows the approximate areas of construction.

Work will be conducted mostly during daylight hours and mostly during the week days. We appreciate your understanding while this work is being completed. Every effort will be made to minimize the disturbance to your household. For your convenience, phone numbers of the project manager, inspector, and contractor are shown below.
