## Shore Drive – Oceanfront Trolley Survey Final Results Summary 7.21.15

- 1) 385 total surveys taken (Over 55 neighborhoods represented)
  - Cape Story 64, Ocean Park 50, Cape Henry Shores -37, Chic's-31
  - North End 10
- 2) Almost 3:1 ratio said they would use the service (246 Y 92 N)
  - Sample of common "No" reasons: Don't want Shore Drive to become the Oceanfront; Will cause overcrowding of Bay beaches; Shore Drive businesses are crowded enough; Shore Drive area needs to stay local.
- 3) (132 or 35%) would like to see service turn around at Pleasure House Road
  - Great Neck Road and Little Creek each received 6 votes for turnaround possibilities
  - Majority of "Other" were "No/Don't do it"
- 4) (147 or 39%) would like to see the service go to 17<sup>th</sup> Street
  - 31st Street was second choice with (92 or 24%) of votes
  - "Other" -Rudee Loop received 17
  - Majority of "Other" were "No/Don't do it"
- 5) Majority (235) would like a bus stop no more than ¼ mile walk (
- 6) Majority (251) would like a bus to stop no more than every 30 minutes
- 7) Majority (214) think a May 1<sup>st</sup> to Sept 30<sup>th</sup> operation is just right
- 8) Majority (194) would use the service weekdays and weekends
- 9) Majority (232) would use the service 1 to 4 times a month
- 10) General comments/opinions were received from (162 or 42%) of survey taken
